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**Andreas Gerber** is the head of health economics department at the Institut fuer Qualitaet und Wirtschaftlichkeit im Gesundheitswesen (IQWiG), the German national institute for quality and efficiency in health care, since August 2009. He also serves as a lecturer (Privatdozent, adjunct professor) of health economics and health services research at the University of Cologne where he holds a position as an assistant professor in health economics at the Medical School of the University of Cologne between 2003 and 2009. As a Harkness fellow in Health Care Policy and Practice he joined the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) in 2007/2008 with research on pediatric health services. In his current position he focuses on finding solutions for technical problems of the efficiency frontier method in health economics.
